How We Can Help

- **Have you worked on a farm in the last two years?**
- **Do you need a GED or training?**
- **Thinking about college?**
- **Are you looking for a job?**

If worked on a farm in the past two years, you may be eligible for job assistance and financial support for job training.

EMDC is a non-profit organization dedicated to helping you reach your goals. We provide financial assistance to offset costs associated with education and training.

EMDC operates the National Farmworker Jobs Program in Maine for economically disadvantaged individuals seeking stable, year-round employment in high growth, high wage occupations.

If you are eligible and need help with school, college, or other training, we can help.

You Could Receive



Tuition Assistance

Assistance with cost of classes and short-term training.

Books and Supplies

Educational materials you will need to succeed.

Transportation Assistance

Mileage reimbursement for travel to and from training.

Child Care Assistance

Reimbursement for child care expenses while you are attending training.

Emergency Assistance

Unexpected expenses such as car repair, medical, or dental.

How You Qualify

Time or Earnings

During a consecutive 12-month period within the past 24-months, 50 percent of time worked or 50 percent of your pay must be from farm work. This includes seasonal work on farms whether planting, processing, or harvesting (blueberries, potatoes, dairy, Christmas trees, etc.).

Family Income

We'll help you find out if your total household income meets federal guidelines.

Other Family Members

Children and spouses of farm workers may be eligible for EMDC's program.
